



Waterfront:

A Lifeguard **must** be present when anyone is entering the water or swimming. Lifeguard's may be provided upon **advance notice** and arrangements at a per hour cost.

If you arrive on site without a lifeguard and have not pre-arranged with the camp to have a lifeguard present you will **not** be allowed to go swimming.

Our Waterfront Activites include: Wakeboarding, Water Skiing, Tubing, Banana Boats, Lake swimming, Kayaking, Surf Bikes, Canoeing, Beach Volleyball, Beach Bar-B-Q

Canoeing and Kayaking are included with no extra charge. Surfbikes are available for \$100 for the length of your stay.

All participants **must** wear lifejackets at all times when using or attempting to use the Surfbikes, Canoes, Kayaks, and all boating activities.

Dry Land Activities:

Outdoor Cooking in our Pizza Oven or Beach Bar-B-Q, Craft Area, 3 Campfire Areas, Playing Field with Sports Equipment, Frisbee Golf, Archery, Riflery, Zip Line & Leap of Faith (seasonal), Bouldering room and Hiking trails.

Archery & Riflery: must have adequately skilled instructors proficient in the activities use & safety procedures. We will provide our staff to you at the cost of \$35.00 per hour/per activity.

The Zipline & Leap Of Faith may only be used under Kawkawa staff supervision. Both of the elements require three of our staff to operate to operate. (\$300 per hour/ minimum 2 hours).

Meeting Rooms & Seminar Areas

We have the following meeting rooms. A meeting room will be allocated to your group by Kawkawa staff depending on your group's size. Please discuss with the booking coordinator if extra rooms are required.

Insurance

You must insure that your group carries its own liability insurance and you must provide a certificate of insurance to Kawkawa, indicating Kawkawa Camp and Retreat as an additional insured party with regard to liability, on your policy for the time you are here. Individuals wishing to bring their own watercraft must also have their own Liability insurance coverage.

Kawkawa Camp & Retreat: Rules, Regulations, & Guidelines

- 1) All vehicle traffic must be DEAD SLOW. Parking is in designated area only.
- 2) Structure or equipment damage will be charged to your group. The cost for a discharged fire extinguisher except in case of legitimate fire fighting will be \$50.00 per unit.
- 3) Children 16 & under who participate in camp activities must be supervised by an adult who is proficient in that particular activity.
- 4) Alcohol beverages and non-medical drugs are forbidden on site
- 5) Kawkawa is a total non-smoking facility. This includes all buildings.
- 6) PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON SITE
- 7) Please use only existing paths and walkways
- 8) A total outside noise curfew is enforced from 11:00 pm to 8:00 am each day in consideration of our neighbors.
- 9) No profanity allowed
- 10) Personal dress and grooming is to be respectfully regardless of gender.

We ask you respectfully to observe these few requests

Please do not....

- Remove any bedding, furniture or equipment from rooms.
- Enter any building which has not been assigned to your group.
- Light fires except in designated fire pits
- Discharge firearms or fireworks
- Damage trees, plants, or molest wildlife
- Wear bare feet or swimsuits in dining room
- Please- no chewing gum on the site
